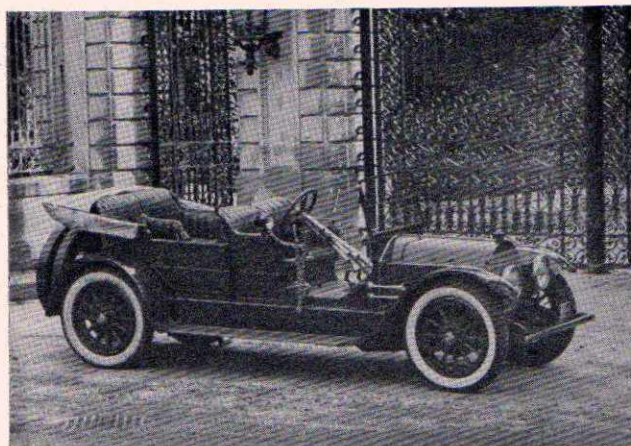
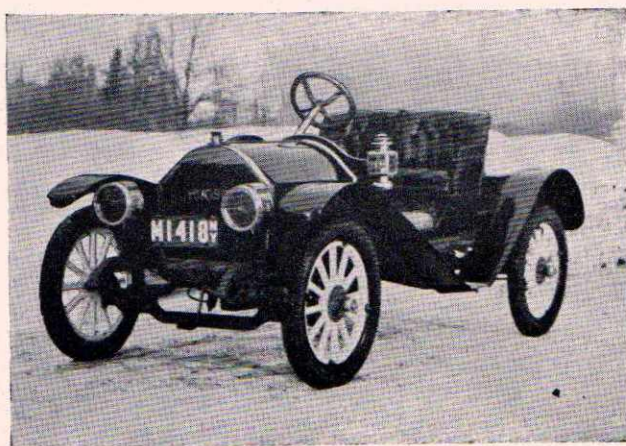


1909 HUDSON SPEEDSTER
